

FACT SHEET INFORMATION : STRATTON MOUNTAIN WEEKEND TRIP

Stratton Mountain Vermont ski trip description

Friday February 24th thru Sunday February 26th, 2012. Downhill skiing, snowboarding, cross country skiing and snowshoeing weekend trip to Stratton Mountain, located in the Green Mountains of Vermont. We will be staying at the Inn at Stratton Mountain and the trip includes: round trip transportation aboard a Shafer motor coach, dinner & dessert & beverages on the bus Friday night, superior rooms with 2 queen beds and a private bath, continental breakfast at the Inn Saturday & Sunday mornings, Saturday night reception at the Inn with snacks and a cash bar, deluxe dinner buffet (roast prime rib, grilled swordfish in a citrus marinade and quartered rosemary & garlic grilled game hen with tossed Caesar salad, pasta salad w/vegetable, roasted garlic mashed potatoes, green beans almondine and blackberry cobbler) at the Inn Saturday night, 2-day downhill lift ticket, and snacks & beverages on the bus Sunday night. Approximately 4 hours from Endicott. The trip departs from the Shafer bus facility in Endicott at 5:30pm, with bus loading beginning at 4:30pm.

Stratton Mountain: Downhill skiing/snowboarding on 92 trails (27% advanced, 31% intermediate and 42% novice) with 14 lifts (including 4-6 packs and a 12-person high-speed gondola to the summit), a 2,003 ft vertical drop (3,875 ft summit elevation) and a longest run of 3 miles. Sun Bowl Adventure Center with cross country and snowshoe trails, with \$20 trail fee. Stratton Sports Center (separate fee) with heated indoor pool, hot tub & steam rooms, cardiovascular & weight equipment, indoor tennis courts, basketball courts, tanning and massage. The Inn provides free shuttle service to/from the main mountain (downhill and snowshoeing), Stratton Sports Center, Sun Bowl area (downhill, cross country and snowshoeing) and the Stratton Village (shopping & dining). You can start/stop skiing at your convenience. The bus will be available on Saturday to take folks into Manchester, VT for shopping (outlet stores) and/or to another near-by cross country ski area (separate trail fees apply).

- 2-day downhill ski/snowboard lift ticket
- 1-day downhill ski/snowboard lift ticket and a \$30 Stratton gift card
- No downhill ski/snowboard lift ticket and a \$60 Stratton gift card
