Lodging - The Scudder Hill House, Roxbury, NY (Includes Continental Breakfast)

Saturday, March 14 - Sunny low-40s

Skiing - Windham Mountain - \$29 through www.Liftoptia.com

Dining - Consensus of those who want to dine. Possibilities are the Brandywine in Windham or Mama Maria’s in Stamford.

Lodging - The Scudder Hill House, Roxbury, NY (Includes Continental Breakfast)

Sunday, March 15 - Sunny low-40s

Skiing - Hunter Mountain – Contact Tim Hanna if you are interested in skiing Hunter on Sunday. We can get a special rate (\$38) but need to purchase a block of tickets as one transaction so I need a list of those interested.

What you need to do:

Sign-up - Contact Tim Hanna

Lodging - If you are staying overnight, call Scudder Hill House for a reservation. They require that you mail them a check as a deposit. See page 2 for a listing of rooms and amenities. Call 607-326-7310 and ask for Rae (pronounced “Ray”)

Dinner reservations - Contact Tim Hanna if you are staying for dinner any of the nights so I can make reservations.

Lift tickets - Purchase **Belleayre tickets** when you arrive at any ticket window. On Friday, the tickets are \$25. (Other days, use your TCSC card for a \$10 discount)

Windham Tickets - Purchase a Club Discount Card at the group sales window for \$20 or purchase tickets online through www.Liftoptia.com for \$29.

Hunter Tickets – Contact Tim Hanna to be added to the list for a group purchase

Walkie-Talkies - Keep walkie-talkies on channel 7.8 to meet up with other TCSC members.

Scudder Hill House Information - This establishment was recommended by Plattekill. It is a renovated vintage house with WiFi, Digital TV and continental breakfast. The following letter from the owners describes the rooms and prices.

Hi Tim,

Per our phone conversation tonight, here is what we have to offer:

- Room 1 - one queen, one single
- Room 2 - two double beds
- Room 3 - one queen

The rooms above have a private entrance and share a full bathroom and living room with TV. Without an eik, \$65 per bedroom (\$195 per night); with and eik, \$250 per night for the entire space.

- Room 4 - one queen, two singles, private full bath, private entrance, TV, sleep four for \$79 per night
- Room 5 - one queen, private bath for \$65 per night
- Room 6 - one queen, private bath, small kitchenette fireplace for \$79 per night
- Room 7 - one queen, private bath for \$65 per night
- Room 8 - is presently being renovated (will have one queen two singles, private bathroom)

The dates you are interested in are available, as of today. The size of our rooms do not include the bathrooms. Part of this house was built in 1860 and Rooms 1, 2, & 3 with kitchen and living room are an extension. Each room has its own thermostat, Room 4 also has radiant floor heating. Rooms 4, 5, 6 & 7 have painted wooden floors, Rooms 1, 2 & 3 have wall-to-wall carpet.

We serve a full continental breakfast in our Common Room located in the main part of this house, which includes hot and cold cereals, fresh fruit, yogurt, hard boiled eggs, English muffins, oj, coffee, tea, and hot chocolate.

Thank you for your interest in the Scudder Hill House, which is only six miles from Plattekill and I believe about ten miles from Belleayre.
